### **About LHS**

Founded in 1978, Sheboygan Lutheran High School is a Christ-centered high school that recognizes the importance of a faith-based education rooted in Biblical truths. While distinctly Lutheran and affiliated with the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS), students from all faiths and denominations are welcome to attend Lutheran High. We are supported by twelve LCMS congregations throughout Sheboygan County.

#### **Student & Faculty Information**

We serve over 200 students. The average class size is 18 with a 12:1 student to faculty ratio. 9 of the 16 faculty members (56%) have advanced degrees in their field.

#### **Accreditation and Graduation Requirements**

Sheboygan Lutheran is fully accredited by National Lutheran School Accreditation. Students must successfully complete 27 credits in order to be awarded a diploma.

Dual credit courses are offered through the CAPP Program at UW-Oshkosh, online courses from Concordia University Wisconsin, and Advanced Placement (AP).

#### **Extracurricular Clubs and Athletics**

Sheboygan Lutheran offers 14 interscholastic high school sport opportunities, music, drama, National Honor Society, student council along with other clubs and national organizations for students to explore and challenge their abilities. Over 90% of our students are involved in at least one activity.
